Do's and Don'ts at IndusInd Bank ATMs



Do's

- > Always carry out your ATM transactions in private
- > Beware of suspicious persons moving around the ATM. DO NOT engage in a conversation with them
- > You should be vigilant for any suspicious devices attached to the ATM machine. They might capture your confidential data
- > Protect your PIN from onlookers by covering the keypad
- > Press the 'Cancel' button before leaving the ATM to ensure that the welcome screen is displayed
- > Remember to collect your card before you leave
- > Register for mobile alerts and report any unauthorized transaction immediately
- Inform your bank immediately if your ATM/ Debit Card is lost/ stolen/ held back at an ATM
- > While destroying your card, cut it through the magnetic strip before disposing it off

➣ Don'ts

- > Do not lend your card to anyone
- > Never write your PIN on the card
- Do not share your PIN or seek help from anybody by handing over the card and revealing the PIN
- > Do not use a PIN that can be easily guessed e.g. your birthday, telephone number, etc.
- Never leave your card inside the ATM

Other Bank Card Holders

- Cash Withdrawals at this ATM by Other Bank Card Holders will be limited to ₹ 10,000 (Indian Rupees Ten Thousand Only) per transaction. There is no limit on number of transactions.
- Customers using cards issued in India may get levied with ATM withdrawal charges on their Savings Account after the fifth transaction at other Bank ATMs.
